Gentlemen;-

I thank you for your letter of the 5th in response to my adv. in the Buyers Guide. Am enclosing a folder which gives the dimensions of the machine and also a list of users in Canada and the States up to the end of 1956. You may check with any of these firms regarding the performance they are getting. The folder states the capacity as 150 pounds per hour which is a conservative average and depends a lot on the quality of timothy being worked. Good heavy rotund timothy that rolls well on the plates will clean 200 pounds per hour and more at times, while blast tailings and salvaged screenings will clean slower.

The price of the machine F.O.B. Waterdown, Canada is \$1980.00 and there is a U.S. Customs duty of 13 $\frac{3}{4}$ % on the U.S. dollar equivalent of that sum at the rate of exchange prevailing on the day customs entry is made and cartage cost will run around \$40.00 bringing your delivered cost around \$2300.00. For the convenience of my customers I take care of the customs entry and prepay the duty and cartage charges and add these expenses to my invoice to you.

Orders now on hand will take till mid-summer to fill, if you get next in line you could expect delivery about late July or August. I offer you the machine on trial, duty and cartage prepaid by me, if after trial you wish to keep it you pay \$1980.00 Canadian Funds plus the actual amount I will have paid in duty and cartage charges getting it to you. If it does not please you after trial you are under no obligation other than to return the machine undamaged when called for.

Dear Mr. Christiansen:-

Have your letter of the 19th and will equip the machine with a $\frac{1}{4}$ hp. 60 cycle, single phase, 110 volt, thermal protected, ball bearing, totally enclosed motor. Use of the 110-220 alternative voltage would not permit the built-in thermal protection so it will be better for this purpose in view of the light load to use the straight 110 volt construction.
